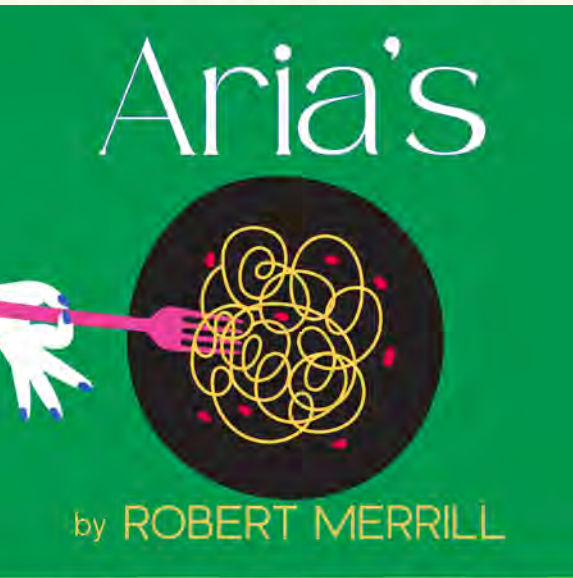

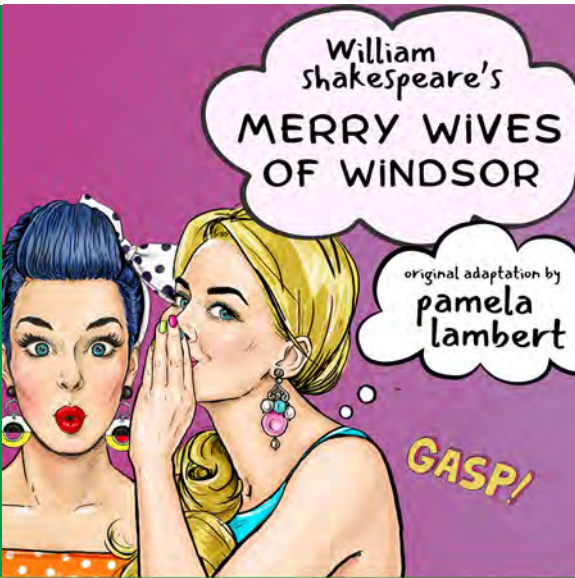
February 13 - March 1, 2026

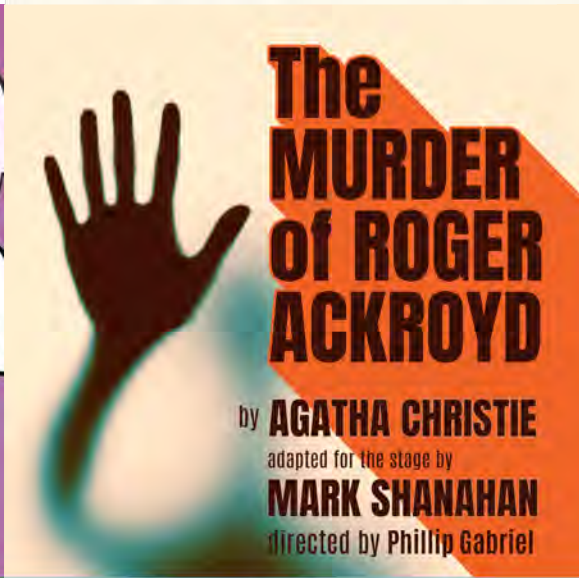


April 10-26, 2026

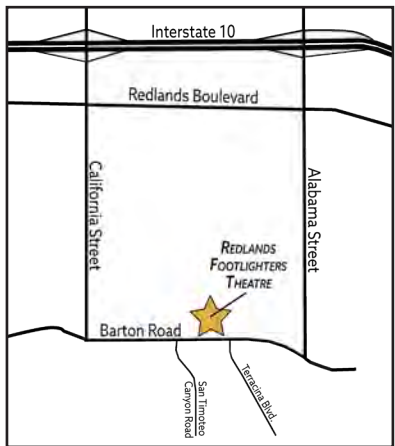
